Social Resources	Help Needed, Moderate	Jesse has some support from the deli owner and his sister is a potential resource. He would like to take action to build more social supports.
Physical/Medical - Dental, Other	Help Needed, Moderate	Jesse reports that he hasn't seen a medical Dr. in some time. He also states his ankles are swollen, he has sores on his feet and tooth pain.
Self-Care/Daily Living	Help Needed, Moderate	Jesse appeared disheveled and there are some concerns about his hygiene. He has holes in his clothes and shoes.
Substance Use	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse acknowledges that he is dependent on alcohol and needs to drink so that he doesn't get sick.
Decision Making	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse has made several decisions that are concerning. He sells and trades his medication, stole liquor from the store, and struck a shop clerk and got arrested while on probation.
Medication Management	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse acknowledges that he has received medication but he sells and trades it and doesn't take it.
Justice Involvement	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse is on probation and was recently arrested for theft and assault.
Residential Stability	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse is homeless.
Financial Resources - Bus Fare, Food/Nutrition, Health Care/Insurance, Legal Fees/Fines, Mortgage/Rent, Other	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse has no income.
Adjustment to Trauma	Immediate Help, Severe	Jesse experiences stress reactions due to Vietnam and is able to acknowledge that his experiences in the war changed him and still impact him today.

He is estranged from his family and acknowledges that this is a need, however he would like to wait to begin rebuilding these relationships as he would like to get clean and stabilize his mental health first. Jesse has some insight and can acknowledge that his experiences in Vietnam are still impacting him today.
